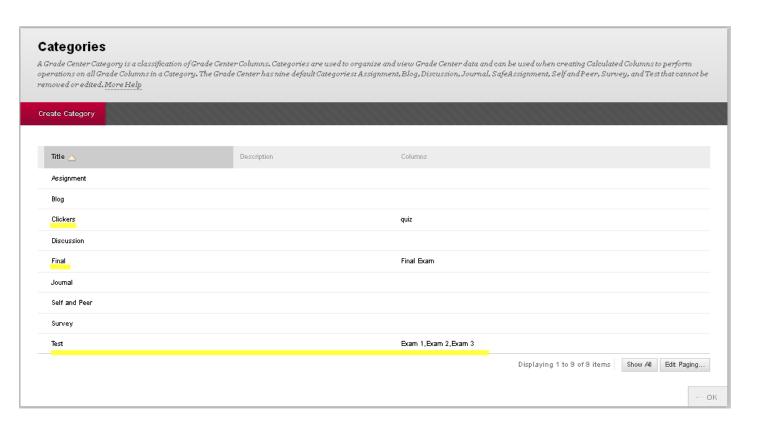
Learn – Weighted Column

From Gradebook, create categories



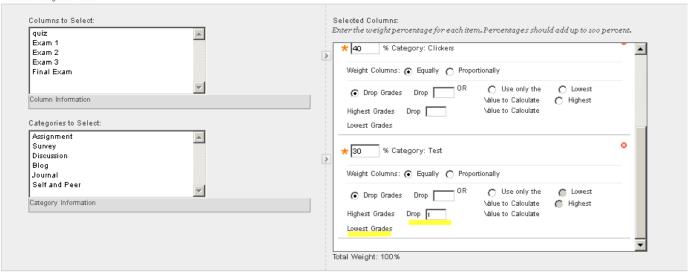
